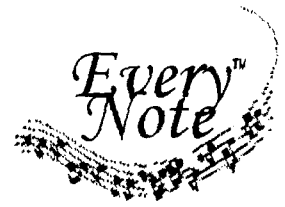


# A. SKRIABIN PRELUDES Op. 11
